Tom: Here's the story. The property name is DLM, Ed Lawrence is the person doing the work. A permit was applied for last year to extract a 500 tonne bulk sample from the property and to transport it to the Ainsworth Mill for processing. The permit was issued, subject to the permits from other agencies for operation of the mill being obtained, but the program didn't do ahead due to problems with either Environment or DFO permitting the operation of the mill. That problem has been rectified now and the bulk sample permit will be issued apparently as soon as some information on tailings disposal, etc. is supplied (which it has not been to date). There has been no new permit application for extraction of more than the 500 tonnes. I am not sure what the projected expenditures are going to be, I will give Ed a call sometime and ask him. I don't get the impression they will be that much but I just started my expenditure estimate spreadsheet for this year. I will keep you informed when I know more.
