Dear Sir:

I am the widow of Dr. Joseph T. Mandy, who was Resident Mining Engineer for the North-Western Mineral Survey District of the B. C. Department of Mines in the thirties. He passed away in 1968.

It was my privilege to travel with my husband in his extensive district stretching from the Queen Charlotte islands to the Yukon and Alaskan borders. At the moment I am recording some of our fascinating experiences as a contribution to Canadiana, the last being in the Smithers area. We climbed on horses to the mining property of A. J. Cope near Telkwa on Dome Mt. where my husband's ashes were scattered at his request, our last campsite together in 1938. In notes I have, this property is referred to as the Dome Mt. property.

1. Was any other name given to the Dome Mt. property and had it been worked before Cope and his partner Chisholm staked it?
2. How far was the property from Telkwa where we mounted our horses?
3. I vaguely recall that my husband eventually interested a Company in taking an option on the Dome Mt. workings but believe an investigation did not result favourably. Can you throw any light on this?
4. Has anything transpired on the property in recent years?
5. Are any pictures of Dome Mt. available?

I shall greatly appreciate any information you can give me.
