Veins strike @  $120^{\circ}/80^{\circ}\text{NE}$

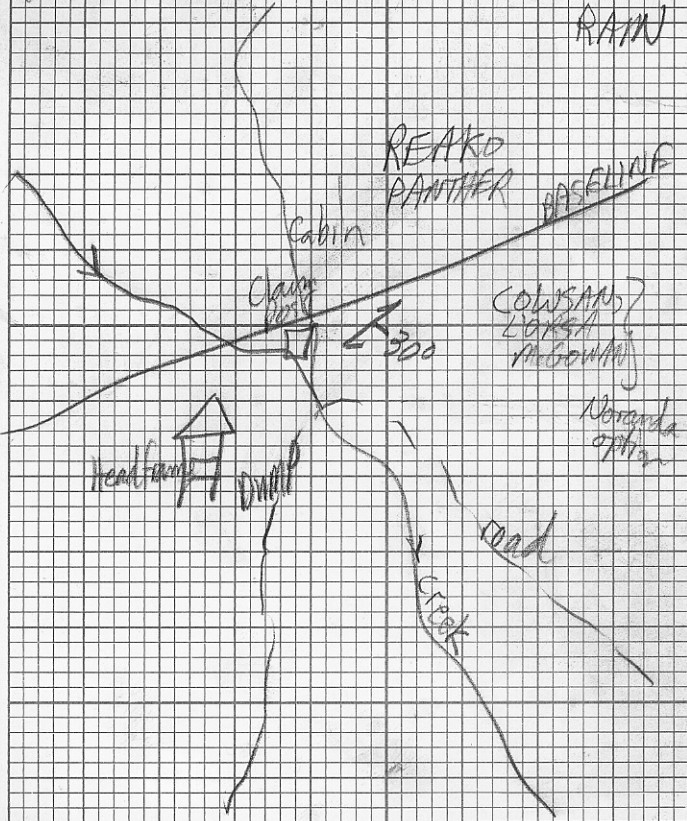
