Tom: Just had a word with Robin Sudo at Chapleau Resources, and it is not clear at this time if they will be doing any work on Zinger or other Cranbrook area holdings this year. So the \$0.5 under Chapleau Reg. might be premature or over-optimistic.

With respect to Chapleau Creek, Roy Ganderton visited the office yesterday. He has put together much of the Chapleau "camp" as a single property, and is going to hire a geologist to do a compilation of existing information. He is calling the property Dore Mountain.
