Typical skarn - ant (pink) + diopside + tremolite

- local intense brecciation
- Intrusive rx. - Nelson both equiv. + younger (post-mineral) Coryell Syenite

- Host rx. = Knob Hill 'greenstones'
- minor MoS_2 at Dead Honda zone

Drvana hypothesized that skarn zone trended NE; Teck believes it trends N-S.

- late-stage chalcedony (lt. blue) and jasper veining.
