- nice model - shows rel. flat dip (~25° W) near surface with 'subsequent' roll to near vertical at depth. Good grades continue at depth (below deepest drilling)
- mesothermal (no banding)
- mainly v.a. but also assoc. w pyrite ∴ ideally want cyanide treatment to produce a concentrate — looking at custom mills - eg. Dankoe, Roberts mills etc.
- looking at possibility of open-cutting near surface (incl. removal of ~1m tons of waste rock above vein). Waste rock does not appear to have any potential for AAD (ie. minor to none py)
- company will need to 'submit' proposal to Victoria
- excellent potential for similar style veins over entire property.
- completely new disc. as a direct result of logging (ie. old mineral inventory showing several km to the south).
- Logging co. poised to bring new road in

off Coquihalla Connector Hwy. to south  
west of ~~the~~ deposit. Will help in  
production logistics.
