# MINERALIZATION

- paddy!
- ZnS + PbS + chalcocite (white or pink)  
+ po
- volcanic environment with  
basinal deposition  
i.e. volc. (and) episode interrupted  
by quiescent 1st dep. 1st  
dep. also interrupted as evidenced  
by blocks of volc. in 1st.
- ab. faulting + minor folding,
- overall potential still remains  
untested by ddh but appears  
small + paddy.
- camp up on ridge between  
Glory Hole + No. 1 zone.
- H<sub>2</sub>O a problem for drilling
- Very rugged area!
- 1st. unit traced westerly across valley!
