- Vine; view looking south over the trenched Vine Vein on the lower right of the screen to Moyie Lake in the background. Ramrod's field office/core logging facility is in the central lower portion of the slide buildings and core racks evident.
- Vine core facility in middle ground and trenched Vine Vein in background.
- 4. Cross section of the Fors vent. It is now somewhat outdated but gives the general idea, particularly the similarity to Sullivan. Comparatively little evidence of the vent activity was exposed at surface.
