DIRECTIONS TO FORT Property:

- ① Turn left before big bridge & entrance to Fort St. John
- ② Take Souchie Rd. (paved), past several farms,
past school
- ③ ~ 10 km - jct. with Cunningham Lk. FSR (on left-hand
side; also - red & black sign "Yekoochi Territory": '900 Road'
- ④ Stay on rd. until sign saying "Entering Yekoochi Territory"
(~ 10 km) → back side of sign says "Leaving YI"
- ⑤ Immediately beyond sign to the right, heading North
('200 Road'
- ⑥ Camp is just 'behind'.

Sulphides: CPY + MoS₂ (frac + dissen)

Geochem: high base metals - incl. PbS, ZnS (+ elev. Bi + Ag) — no Sb, Au

- Soils + rocks only (no silt/water geochem)

Discovered by: Cat operator ^(Elden Nyberg) + Richard Haslinger, Sr. during construction of logging rd.

- mainly in NW direction

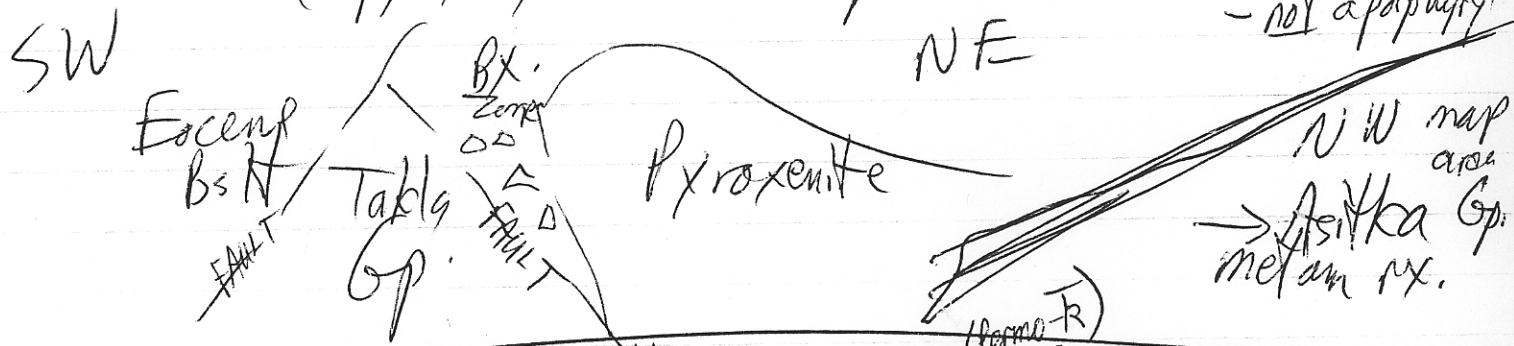
