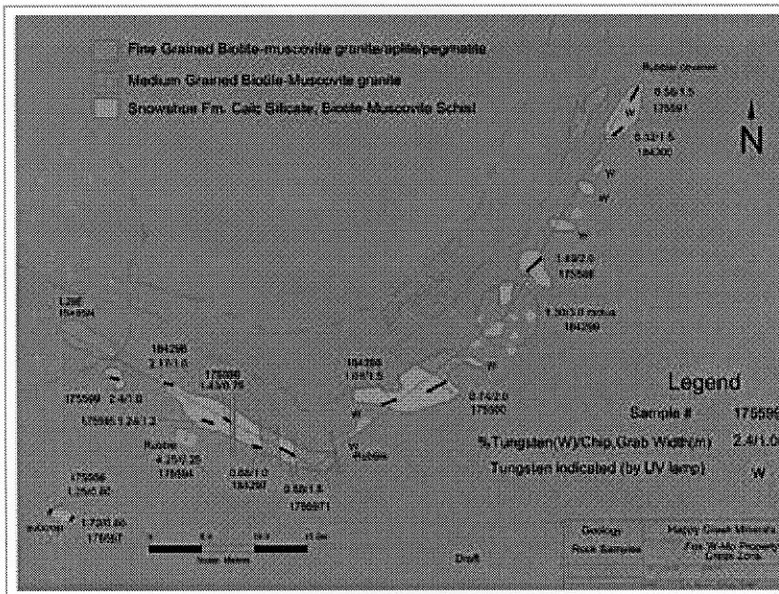

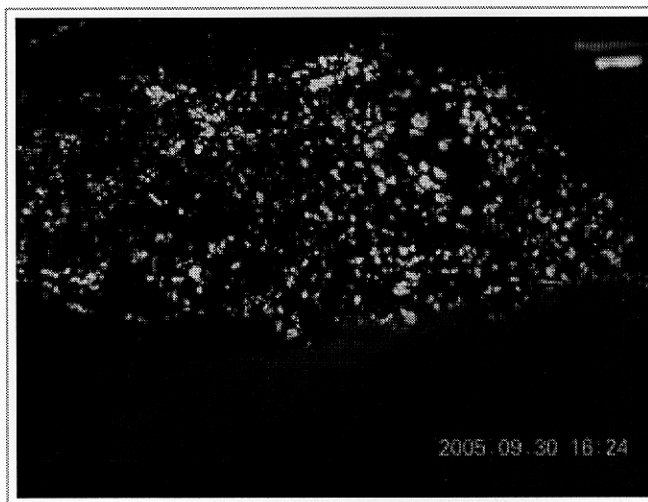

## Fox: 50 metres of tungsten skarn zone found



Happy Creek Minerals is pleased to report that outcrop of "good" tungsten (as indicated by lamping with UV light) was located just north and

northeast of the Nightcrawler tungsten zone(photo-Scheelite under UV)- and is the best exposure of this zone to date. 13 representative samples were obtained over a 50 metre wide exposure and are being submitted immediately for assay.

Several beds of 2 metres or more in thickness appear similar in grade to those located previously to the southwest (1-3% tungsten), and the edge of the zone are covered by sand and gravel and remain open.

The company believes that the 100% owned Fox property has potential high grade and a very large tungsten deposit. Although no drilling is done to date, grid power within 15 km and existing road access in place provides a low-cost mining scenario.
