Dear Tom:

Enclosed is your complimentary copy of the Frasergold Project video as prepared by Bob Switzer and others. It is not the final copy as we hope to do one more and integrate it with this one, and include comments by other important people.

We are presently drilling the main mineralized zone on the property using reverse circulation drilling with the object to develop some mineral inventory, nominally 3 to 5 million tons of open pitable material grading between 0.05 to 0.15 ounces gold per ton.

We have found that sample preparation is paramount for assessing this property. It is necessary to homogenize a large representative sample by fine pulverizing and/or grinding before selecting a sample for assaying. This minimizes the variance to an acceptable value and thereby gives us an assay result that we can rely on. Previous operators apparently did not pay much attention to this aspect.

We will endeavour to keep you up to date as we proceed.
