Hello Chelsea, Sorry for the delayed reply - as usual I am trying to manage a challenging workload.

Please express my best wishes to Mr Liu and his guest from China. I am most pleased to know that Dehua is also looking at the the Belcourt properties for consideration of investing in a new mine. The coal properties in this area are different from those in the Gething project area, and the First Nations issues are still important but generally less contentious.

As you know, the Gething project licence is in good standing, and we have just approved the exploration permit. Dear Glen,

I am in Beijing right now and will be back to Vancouver on Oct. 30<sup>th</sup>. On November 6<sup>th</sup>, Mr. Chonghui Zhang, the director of State owned Assets Supervision and Administration Commission who controls all the government owned coalmines in the largest coal producing province in China - Shan Xi province (annual coal output is 600 million tones), will visit Canada and Dehua, together with some key persons from coalmines in Shanxi. I shall accompany this delegation to Chetwynd and Tumbler Ridge for a mine site visit.

Under the support and assistance from Ministry of Energy and Mines, our Gething Project is going smoothly up to now. We need to do some further exploration in the area to further identify mine engineering design. We are very happy to know that our application for drilling exploration is being processed by the ministry; and once we get the permits, we shall start drilling exploration right away.

Another huge potential coal property Dehua possessed is <u>Belcourt Coal</u> property. The geologists believe that there is better coal resources there compared with Gething and our Geologists from China also pay a high evaluation on this property. Therefore the main target of <u>Chinese delegation</u> is <u>Belcourt Property</u> this time and they are going to visit the mine site while staying in Canada. Dehua has made the application on the tenure for extension of Belcourt area on August 31<sup>st</sup> to MEM. As there are no First Nations issues involved in this area, it our hope that Dehua can be granted the coal license earlier, so that we can conduct further geological exploration soon.

Once again, appreciate your generous support to Canadian Dehua. I am looking forward to meeting you

soon.
