- Orphan Boy committed (with Imperial Metals) to spend minimum \$100,000 on the Goldstream option by Dec. 31, 2000. Thus, at the very least, OB plans to drill the fold nose on the east side of the Goldstream deposit this year!

- Craig Payne running drill program. Gordon Gibson (ex-Goldstream) also on site.
- 'Missed' on first 3 holes → moved ~500m to west at (4th hole) — into HW, phyllite (getting close to a HW garnet horizon immedi. above ore zone?) — 'encouraged'
- Orphan Bay 'dealing' with Imperial Metals on SPIRE property — took excavator from M. Polley & trenched up slope along strike of 'discovery' showing.  
→ "Exciting rocks" (C)
- OB wants to move drill (from Goldstream) onto SPIRE (verbal agreement between Pierre LeBel (IM) & Ron Coombes (OB) — but need 'blessing' of Murray Edwards (IM, Calgary 'boss') before drilling starts
