RE: EXPLORATION FOR VMS DEPOSITS

This letter is a reminder of our discussion this past Saturday with Craig Payne, P.Geo., regarding the exploration for VMS deposits near the World Class Sullivan deposit in southeastern British Columbia vs exploration in the VMS terrane north of Revelstoke.

When you read the attached, "Exploration Highlights Kootenay Region – 1998" it is obvious that exploration results being achieved in the area look very similar to the Revelstoke VMS terrane. That is, lots of high-grade narrow VMS intercepts or low-grade wider VMS intercepts. If these exploration companies did not know that the multi-billion dollar Sullivan deposit did exist nearby they would not be drilling the +1,000 metre holes – and probably would have "written off" the area long ago.

There is no reason to believe that because there are some ten known small to medium size VMS prospects and deposits in the Revelstoke area, that there is not a World Class deposit yet to be discovered, nearby.
