The **Cu-Mo PROPERTY** is located British Columbia in the Kamloops Mining District at Longitude 119° 13' 30"W., 51° 53' 30" N, on NTS map sheet 082M/14E. The property covers a 1.0 by 1.0 km (100 hectares) area east of the North Thompson River and northwest of Groundhog Mountain between Blue River and Avola. 2 season road access to the property is available from the Yellowhead Highway via the Finn Creek logging road 15.5 km north of Avola then to the Camp Creek logging road 10 km up the Finn Creek road. The claims are centered at the 9 km post on the Camp Creek road. The claims are owned 100% by Leo J. Lindinger.

The Claims cover Cretaceous to Tertiary diorite to granodiorite, Devonian? orthogneiss and Proterozoic? paragneisses of the Shuswap Metamorphic Complex. In July and August 1999 mineralized diorite and paragneiss float reporting up to 0.2% copper, 0.1% molybdenum. Also found were "Bizar Style" quartz-pyrrhotite-chalcopyrite stockwork veined paragneiss float reporting up to 15 ppb gold. It is assumed the float originated from nearby bedrock sources buried under locally derived glacial debris. Most of the mineralized float is located along the road way within 75 meters of the IP.

The property has no recorded exploration history. There are expired two-post claims dating from the early 1980's.
