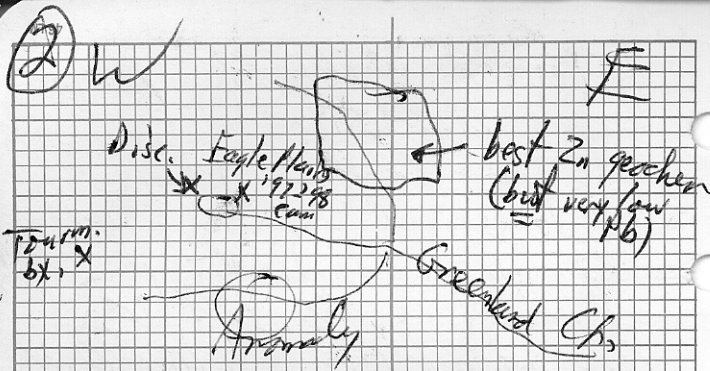

- Silt and soil geochem complete area + detailed (cf. ICP) - esp. Zn - Pb - As - Bi - Th - Be - Cd
(As regionally = 7-13 ppm)

- Note: W ± Beryllium veinlets assoc. with young(?) Greenland Ck. intrusions (± pegmatites)

* Stratigraphy downsection (cf. Findlay/Doctor Ck) in lower Middle Afton ridge i.e. closer to LMC target & - also more gabbroic (Moyie) sills.



→ plan is to assimilate all geology & geochem., plus later in 1999 or early 2000 — EM surveys over selected areas.

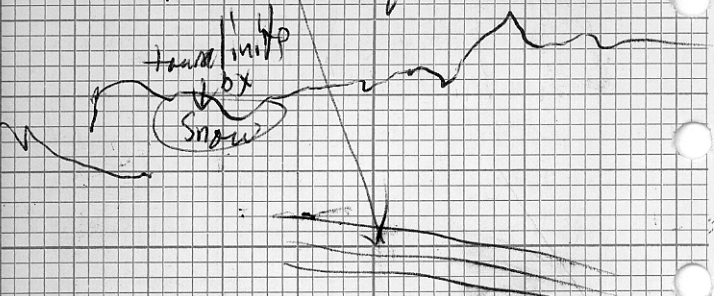
