"Alteration - Guide to ore+ " course drew 21 participants and was well received. Participants were about equal mix of prospectors and geologists, primarily local. Huckleberry-Silver Queen field trip drew 21 as well. All first-time visitors were greatly impressed by the tenor of mineralzizaiton in the pit, and unfortunately in the NAG quarry, used for construction purposes.

Smithers Exploration Golf tournament was a rousing success. 68 golfers and 98 for dinner. All foursomes won a prize but had to sing karoke style to claim it.

Drilling is underway at Huckleberry, beginning near the NAG quarry at the south end of the Main zone stock.

Reviewed Big Onion core from 1991 drilling program which is stored at Tony L'Orsa's farm. Al McNutt (Rio Algom) was examining the core, Peter Karelse was familiarizing himself with rock types prior to Consolicated Magna's drill program which is just underway. Looking for faulted offset of ore zone, testing IP anomaly.

Examined HD (Harry Dayls) property of prospectors Wes Moll and Dan Merkley with Mike Vanderguchte of Rubicon Minerals. Rhyolite hosted zinc-lead and andesite hosted copper-silver mineralization. Possible VMS target, worthy of further work.
