- 1930, p. 64 - orig. cls. staked in 1927 on east side of h.
- 12 cls. owned by C.W. Meldrum + Assoc. of Vancouver
 - 13 miles from head of Kutze Inlet (8 $\frac{1}{4}$ miles from Detroit Western Mining Co. railway camp terminus)
 - camp at 950 ft. on east side of north br. of North fork of Kutze R.
 - 1929 + 1930 - further disc. on west side 1200' to 2750'.
 - late 1930 - prop. optioned to Van. parties.
 - lenses of pyrite with high Au values in qtz. veins in qtz. diorite with streaks of aplite, micro-peg. + dk. bbkic-rk.
 - sa. of selected py + qtz. containing ~75% py (lens 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ' x 11")
assayed: 6.75 g/t Au; 2.60 g/t Ag + 3.2% Cu.
 - sericitized wall rk. (+ py, siderite, ankerite) = "0".
- Other assays: .35 Au; .1 Ag
- main showing - 1850' to 2750' - py. lenses
 - qtz.-filled gash veins + stringers, i.e. contraction (cooling)
 - gneissic + flow structure, schlieren, banding - etc.

1932 - see Bull. No. 1, 1932 p. 34-37
C.W. Meldrum died

1933 - crew of 3 men + owners
- 3 tons of ore mined from surface atops. + shipped
= 30g Au; 12g Ag; 88 lbs Cu.

1939 - J.M. Meldrum + J.G. Campbell optioned to P.W. Race + Seattle interests.
- expl. + devel. commenced.

1940 - 9 men sank shaft - 150 ft. + two 50-foot drifts
