COMMENTS (significant results, zones tested, short geological description):

A coincident Cu-Au soil anomaly (1.6 x 100-550m) overlies a thick succession of andesite porphyry flows & flow breccias intruded by a sill-like body of diorite. No obvious alteration zones or significant mineralization seen. For malachite stained fractures & quartz veins unobserved that may indicate the presence of a large scale hydrothermal cell. To the south is an area underlain by andesitic tuffs, overlying calcareous sediments & capped by andesite porphyry flows, a 100m x 25m x 6m thick massive magnetite-epidote skarn showing was mapped & sampled.
