

KET 28 [MI-82ESW?]

On May 7, 1996 I accompanied Trygve Hoy, Gerry Ray, Mike Cathro, Larry Jones and Paul Wilton to the Ket 28 gold prospect located just SE of Bridesvale. John Chapman, Gold City Mining Corp., very kindly toured us around. During Feb.-Mar.'96, Gold City drilled 17 diamond drill holes testing a silicified, pyritized breccia containing quartz-calcite veinlets. In 1994 a drill intersection in this area yielded an assay of approximately 11 feet grading 1.5 opt Au. The core is stored in Grand Forks at John Carson's place. A large I.P. anomaly in an area of no outcrop and no previous drilling, located to the southeast, is the next target. [Ref. Schroeter MR, June '94].
