CREEK AND THEN WENT TO THE EASTERLY SIDE AND DONE COFFEE CREEK AND
ACROSS THE MAIN LAKE TO CRAWFORD CREEK AS WELL AS SOME WORK IN THE
KASLO AREA. THE AREA OUTLINED IN RED IS THE APPROXIMATE BOUNDARIES
OF THE PROPERTY HELD BY KING JACK RESOURCES.
