KLI / KLIYUL [MI 94D 019, 113]

On August 18th Paul Wojdak and I flew over Hemlo Gold's Kliyul property. In 1994, Hemlo drilled ten holes (1120m) testing a zone of hydrothermal magnetite (+Au +Cu) associated with a porphyry system (i.e. replacement vs skarn target). Kennecott and Vital had previously outlined about 2.4 million tons grading 0.06 opt Au, 0.45% Cu, and 0.2 opt Ag. No further drilling was done in 1995.
