Minnova Inc. and Falconbridge Ltd., having abandoned their exploration warehouses at Chemainus, have both transferred all of their drill core to the Coronation zone clearing on the LARA property.

The attached sketch shows the distribution of palletted core relative to the adit portal and other features. Minnova has constructed a 24' x 16' wood building with corrugated steel roof for more secure storage of the significant Coronation zone intersections. All other core is cross-stacked to heights of 4 or 5 feet on pallets. The pallets are well spaced for easy access to any specific core.

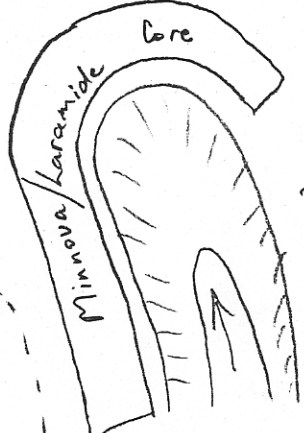

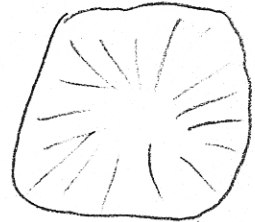
