1994 - 9 holes - on IP amandites
to east of main alt'n 'knob'

1992 - 2 dth by Cyprus
(in ck to N of 'knob')

early 1960s: Noranda (2 dth)
+ Wolverton (2 dth?).

- Andre set up camp on small pond
between old camps (core) + alt'd knob.

- drop off in open 'mass' area to west
of alt'n knob + hike down ck

@ 010° to look at scoriaite
± pyrophyllite + hematite alt'd

vein with alt'd amds. dykes (4px)

→ Cyprus drilled 2 holes into zone
