LIMONITE CREEK (MI 93 L 075)

July '95

On the morning of July 22, 1995 Andre Panteleyev, and myself toured the Limonite Creek property with owner Will Thompson. Golden Hemlock Explorations (Tatsi project) very kindly loaned us the services of Will plus the camp helicopter. The visit was in 'preparation' for a further examination by Andre as part of his investigation of advanced argillic systems with (potential) enargite in B.C. We examined the main andalusite - scorzalite - corundum - sericite - pyrophyllite - hematite showing hosted in altered volcanic rocks in a small creek flowing northerly into Mamy Bear Creek (Note: Cyprus Canada drilled 2 holes under this showing in 1992). We also examined the silicified and sericitized resistant knob, around which Will Thompson drilled 9 holes in 1994 testing I.P. anomalies. Unfortunately, no economic values were encountered; nevertheless, the alteration zoning is very intriguing (i.e. Equity Silver type). The core is stored on site (see photos). Andre stayed on the property for the next four days.

This project was awarded a 1995 EXPLORE B.C. grant; unfortunately, the owner has been unable to secure financing.
