McConnell Creek Gold Property

Acquired in 1981, the McConnell Creek Property in north-central B.C. is wholly-owned by Gerle Gold. Property details include:

- Claim area 10,255 acres
- Exploration to date \$2.4 million
- Volcanic associated vein and shear zone gold; deposits of this type include: Yellowknife NWT, Porcupine (Timmins) Ontario and the Mother Lode Belt of California
- Vein and shear zone system traced for seven miles; 1,000 feet detailed by trenching located two zones as follows:

*(last trench ran 0.232 opt Au across 5.9 feet and leaves zone open on strike)

- Potential for 1,000,000+ ounces

Sugar Lake Massive Sulphide Property

Discovered in 1986, this Vernon Mining District property in south-central B.C. is owned 100% by Gerle Gold Ltd. Property details include:

- Precambrian volcanogenic massive sulphide type. Best assay 2.16% Cu, 1.37% Zn, 0.25 opt Ag over width of 100 feet
- Property in early exploration stage; expenditures \$40,000 to date

The Company is encouraged by the work to date but has no plans for work on the property in 1997.
