RESULTS OF MISTY PROGRAMME

Results of the company's 1990 exploration programme on the Misty claims are now available. The project is located 55 kilometres west-northwest of Germansen Landing, in the Omineca porphyry copper-gold belt which hosts the Mt. Milligan deposit. The wholly owned claims contain the Misty deposit, with approximately 3 million tons grading 0.63% copper in the Main Showing Zone, while directly adjoining properties contain the Boundary deposit (7.7 million tons at 0.55% copper) and the Lorraine Deposit (10 million tons at 0.67% copper).

Outside of the known deposit Aranlee has discovered several new areas of mineralization. An area of alteration associated with a shear zone, has previously returned assay values from grab samples of up to 0.754 oz/ton gold, 45.7oz/t silver, 6.7% lead and 1.22% zinc. Recent sampling along strike has returned assays of 0.079 oz/ton gold with lead and zinc greater than 1% (definitive assay values awaited).

Elsewhere on the property high grade copper-gold boulders have been discovered, with five samples averaging 0.146 oz/ton gold, 5.88 oz/ton silver and 15.08% copper. Individual assays were as high as 0.199 oz/ton gold, 22.5% copper and 8.41 oz/ton silver from different samples.

In addition to the areas above, rock sampling returned assays above 1% copper from five other outcrops, with gold assays up to 0.06 oz/ton.

The 1990 programme confirms the existence of a strong copper-gold association on the property and indicates the potential for higher grade mineralization peripheral to the Misty deposit. The 1990 data is currently being compiled, prior to the planning of the 1991 follow up exploration programme.
