Morrison - Second release of 2001 ddh results, all holes are -45 degrees on 60 metre grid:

Mountain Boy Minerals - drilling on the High Grade vein (104A 011) showed it to be mis-named. Best silver values were below 1000 ppm silver in all 12 holes, with 1-1.5% lead+zinc. Property is on American Creek, near Stewart. All holes were drilled from one pad at different azimuths and dips!

Wadsworth gold vein - Respond to inquiry from Saskatoon-based company. Geological consultant to examine property within next few weeks.

Teck conducted reconnaissance exploration, in Sept, for Eskay mineralization in Whitesail area. Followed up on mapping by Diakow and Koyanagi (GSB map 1988-2) that shows rhyolite in Smithers Formation, upper part of Hazelton Group. Right stratigraphic position but strictly subaerial environment and no mineralization. Teck (Graeme Evans) is optimistic that Stewart area targets will be drilled next year, but fall-out of Cominco merger still in progress (more lay-offs) and story could change.

RDN - Newmont reps, David Groves (Director, international exploration) and Richard Gorton visited Smithers office, trying to assess how RDN compares to other Eskay targets and how/ if to proceed with exploration. En route to the property to review drill core. Newmont will compile data from previous drilling by Noranda (Wedge zone) and on former Forgold property, south of RDN. Will Newmont continue to drill next year? Stay tuned..
