Re: **XRD Specimen - Battle Zone**

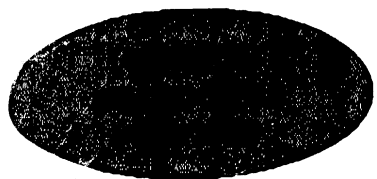
