DUEL LAKES - NEWCOMBE LAKE AREA

Newcombe Lake Area 885937

a) 'Newcombe' (New)

On September 14 Paul Wojdak, Bob Lane and I visited the Duel Lakes-Newcombe Lake area located approx. 100 kms SSW of Houston. Recent logging in the area has resulted in new mineral discoveries including a massive 16 cm vein of barite, galena, sphalerite, chalcopyrite and tetrahedrite in altered volcanic rocks. (see photo).

b) L&H (MI 93E072)

On September 14 we met with one of 4 co-owners (Mike Shelford) and examined chalcopyrite - molybdenite -pyrite showings in hornfelsed mafic volcanic rocks and granodiorite located at the east end of 'Johnny David'/Gordeaux lake. They had 'popped' a few holes to better expose some showings and had apparently shopped the property around. Rumor was that Cominco had submitted an option agreement.

TGS Comment: The amount of logging over the past 15 years in this area has opened up considerable areas with good potential for 'porphyries' (see photo).
