Dear Tom,

I enclose a few souvenir pictures of your trip in our neck of the woods. Some preliminary assay results have just come in; we haven't found the geld-quartz structure we were looking for, although we traced the fleat halfway up the glacier (on the surface). The source must be way up near the peak of Mt. Ottarasko and some of it gets scraped up onto the glacier by avalanches.

Interesting results for the boulder train showing quartz veinlets in a ladder structure (you took a picture of that, and I send you my own version of the same). I sent in 2 samples; one gave 8.2 gr/t Au, 24 gr/t Ag and in excess of 2% copper; the other gave over 10 gr/t Au (precise amount will be forthcoming in an over-limit fire assay) and 0.8% Cu. We have located the source area for these boulders, but it will take further prespecting (of the rope and piton type!) to get a clear picture of what's there and to do a decent sampling job.
