- mid-Sept/92 - Mike Casselman indicated results were 'disappointing'
- turns out to be a Mississippi valley type target (cf. Sedex-clastic)
 - strong structural complexities
 - still an interesting target, but 'slow down'

Sept. 28/92 - Nick Carter talked to Bill Wolfe

- poor results but still interesting area

History of Discovery

1990 - Cominco noted 'open' ground in the area around the old Weber showing, south of the Osilinka River. They initiated an orientation geochem survey (soils) over 'flat' ground. The baseline apparently went 1.3 km south of the showing. Pb-Zn-Ag soil anomaly appeared towards the end of the line = new PAR discovery!
