

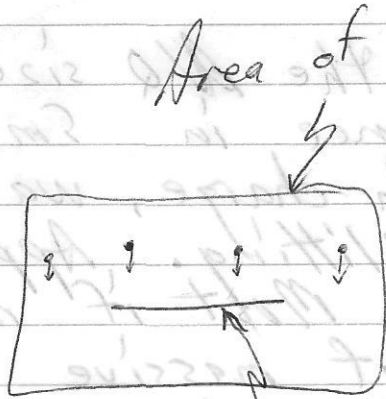
CORE EXAMINATION - FRENCH PEAK - May 28/76

On May 28th I examined the NQ size drill core at Homenuke's residence in Smithers. Alex (Pidge) Homenuke, geologist in charge, was in the process of logging and splitting. Approx. 700 ft. was drilled in 11 holes. Most if not all holes encountered vein(s) of massive ~~tetrahedrite~~ tetrahedrite and/or galena and/or chalcopyrite with disseminated pyrite in the adjacent country rock, obviously related to fracturing + mineralization of vein material. Pidge is also splitting the disseminated material for assays. The general geology appears to be fairly simple - a sequence of acid (rhyolite) flows and tuffs (crystal + lithic) apparently underlain and in contact with ^{ie. Subvolcanic} andesitic rocks (tuffs and amygdaloidal). The development of the mineralized structures appears to be localized just above the rhyolite - andesite contact, in the rhyolite. Bleaching along veinlets is common in the rhyolites. A distinctive ^{non-mineralized} amygdaloidal andesite (calcite) was encountered in the bottom of a few holes.

Preliminary plotting of drill intersections by Homenuke appears to confirm the existence at depth of a mineralized structure. More surface exploration on the remaining claims will be carried out. (more claims were staked recently). If assay results are favourable (& the stock of Aalenian Resources is moving) a 500 ft. adit is proposed.

Area of 1976 drilling

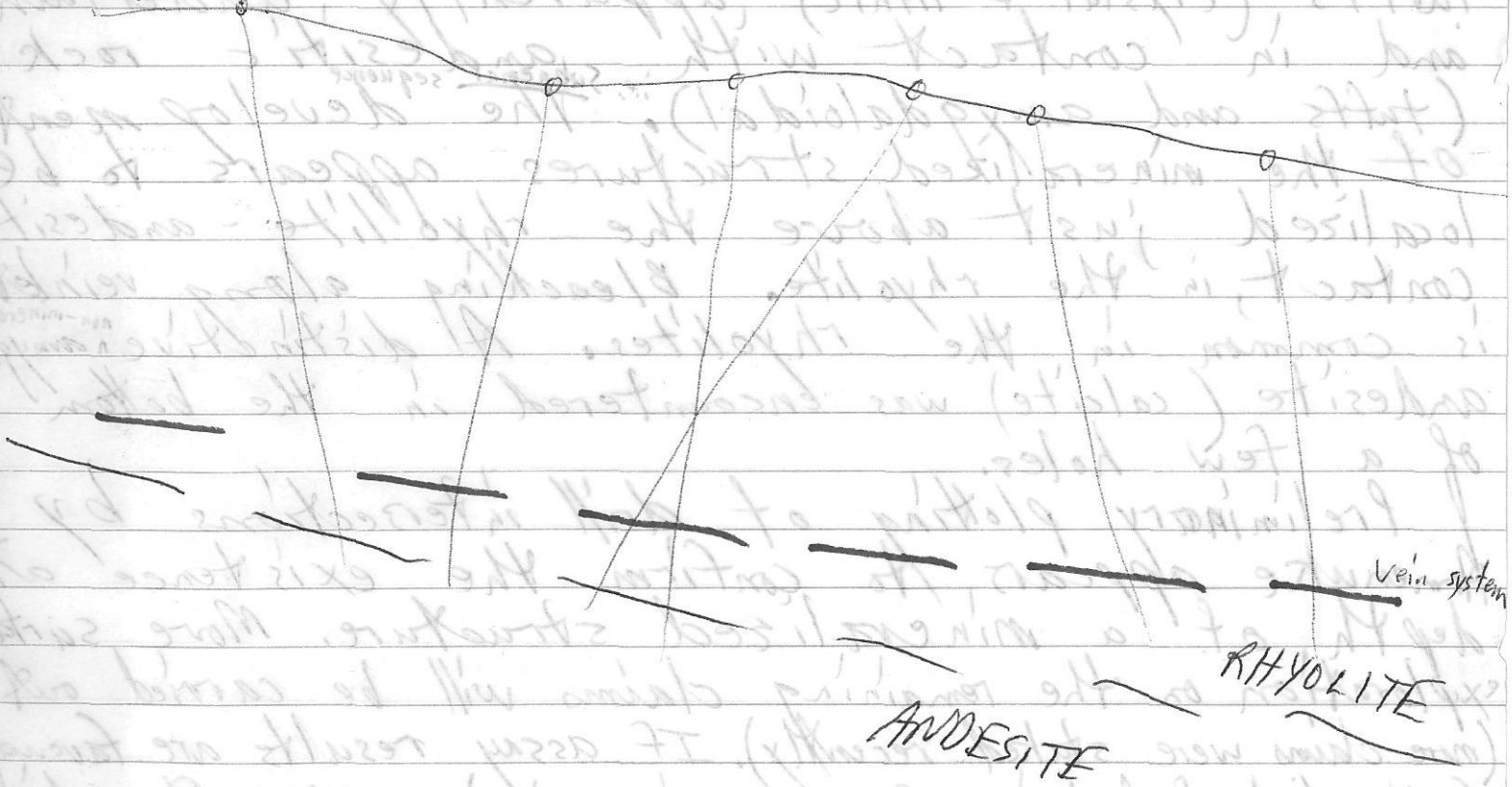
Mineralized structure (trenched)
