## ABOVE AVERAGE MINE MAKING POTENTIAL FOR FAIR HARBOUR'S PITT ISLAND PROPERTY

According to Mark Rebagliati, Fair Harbour's consulting geological engineer, past work by BP Resources and US Borax suggests that there is potential for at least 3 million tons of reserves in the company's polymetallic, massive sulphide property situated on Pitt Island, in northwestern British Columbia, with considerable potential for expanding this figure. In a phone interview with Mr. Rebagliati from the Mt. Milligan Project of Continental Gold Corp., on which he is also consulting, he said that for an undrilled property this previous work has brought the Pitt Island claims into an advanced stage of exploration, comparing it to that of Mt. Milligan three years ago.

Rebagliati has a number of major credits in his 20 year career including the co-discovery of the Red-Chris copper-gold porphyry property in the Iskut Camp and being part of the team that located the QR deposit now under development. And, after conceiving the original exploration program he is an integral part of the Mt. Milligan operation which is shaping up as a major discovery.
