FIELD WORK

Visited Mariko claims and Golden Eagle claims owned by PAP grantees Mary and Larry Lutjen. Both properties are on NTS 82M/3 near Scotch Creek north of Shuswap Lake. At Mariko week galena mineralization occurs in quartz veins cutting marble. 600 m north weekly disseminated and very thin laminations and stringers of pyrite occur in black shale (Sicamous Fm?) suggesting a (lonshot) potential for Sedex Pb-Zn. On the Golden Eagle property west of the Scotch Creek Fault, disseminated pyrite (+aspy?) occur in sericitized Cretaceous granite uphill from a productive portion of the Scotch Creek placer. About 400 soil and rock samples have been collected on each property. No assays yet. The presence of "massive sulphides" and "barite" described by Larry in the PAP grant application seems to be an exaggeration.

EXPLORATION NEWS

Getty South - Tom reports that drilling results have been dissappointing - tonnage potential limited. No further work planned.

Watson Bar - Durfeld reports that 14 holes totalling a bit over 5000' were drilled, all in the vicinity of the main trench at Zone V. Waiting for assays now before deciding on the next phase of work.

Munro Lake - Tom reports 7 ddh completed with assays pending.

Rabbit - Proam Explorations Corp have optioned this Cu-Mo property from R. Bruaset and plan 15 ddh (NOW).

OTHER ACTIVITIES

Sent out approx 100 faxes/notices for Sept 19 field trip to Eagle Bay. About 15 people signed up so far.

Plans complete for Sept 17 RG field trip to Watson Bar. Agenda for Sept 18 meeting nearly ready to go to managers etc.

Met with Robin Whiteaker to go over Lac La Hache paper for Fieldwork.

*Wyse-Rabbit (ProAm Explorations Corp.). NEW GOLD DISCOVERY - DDH 9 hit 10 m grading 15.3 g/t Au within the Durrand Diorite near Domenic Lake, SW of Kamloops. Director Ben Ainsworth says they do not yet know at what angle they intersected the zone. Ground geophysics will be done to try to determine which way it strikes. Property owned and project managed by Ragnar Bruaset. This discovery was unexpected as they were testing Cu-Au porphyry potential. Another hole hit 27.52 m grading 0.41% Cu and 0.19 g/t Au.

*Attended TLC meeting in Vanc. yesterday. GSB was given the rumoured \$1 million lift. A few partnerships are also lined up. Confidentiality will not be allowed. Great concern amongst TLC members over potential effect on worldwide exploration due to Bre-X saga. The chill will probably affect BC too.

Similco - Princeton reported a large loss for the year ended Dec 31 and have written down the value of the Simlco property by \$10.7 million. They have increased the provision for reclamation for Similco by \$3.6 mil.

* Toured YEP candidate Yana Preston through office. She will tentatively start May 5th and stay for 4 months. She is waiting for offer letter from Victoria.

* Reviewed and graded 22 PAP proposals.

* Field visit to Dot property, Guichon Creek area with Gary Stewart of Alhambra Resources (Calgary). Interesting new bornite-rich, linear zone of porphyry -style mineralization in overburden-covered area on east side of Guichon Cr. batholith. Majors are sniffing around.

* Field visit to Wyse-Rabbit property of Pro-Am Expl., located SW of Kamloops near Domenic Lake. Ragnar Bruaset showed me core and maps of this area with Nicola volcanics intruded by the Durrand and Roper Lake stocks. Despite over 150 drill holes in the general area, Ragnar is still coming up with interesting targets and results. On Mar 19 ProAm released the results of hole 97-7 which intersected 10 m grading 15.3 g/t Au in Durrand Diorite. In core this zone has strong albite and weak epidote alteration and contains up to 10% disseminated py. It appears that the hole may have been drilled at a low angle to the mineralized zone. Nevertheless, it has some similarities to Nicola-hosted gold mineralization like Coquihalla (Afton area) and perhaps QR and Shear. 34

* Watson Bar - Stirrup Creek released the results for DDH 97-03 today. It hit 4.66 m grading 0.225 opt Au which included 2.00 m grading 0.491 opt Au (therefore, the other 2 m only averaged .034 opt Au - they are stretching assays here). The intersection is reported to be 90 m down dip of hole 96-11 from last year which hit 3.66 m grading 0.764 opt Au (Zone has now been traced for about 250 m down dip from the big trench at zone V). It should be remembered that the holes here are getting very deep - hole 97-03 hit the zone at 243 m (about 800 ft) below the surface.

* PGR (Ron Wells, Paul Watt) - Cambridge Minerals has dropped option. Another company is apparently ready to take over.

* Hed Moly (Summerland) - Verdstone-Molycor announced they have started drilling.

* Getty: April 14 News release announced a \$3 million budget and that 16,000 m drilling is planned for '97. They also report 4 new IP anomalies have been located. Some of these are not new and we have been waiting for them to test them for two years. Southwest Extension drilling results were released with the top of mineralization being hit at 180 to 250 m and the best grades at over 300 m. Stripping ratio is getting very high in this direction!
