Jerry Bidwell had called me on the issue of certain mineral claims in the Nation Lakes Park area.

This issue relates to the large block of claims (120,000+ha.) registered by Clinton Smyth on January 12, 2005. The claims are now in the name of Redton Resources.

Jerry Bidwell's company is managing an airborne survey of the area and has run into weather and other logistics issues. He had two questions; 1) maintaining title beyond the January 12, 2006 expiry date and 2) the possibility of a holding bond for the proposed airborne survey to allow for full exploration credit now, with the promise that the work would be done next summer.

On 1), we worked through what they have done and it appears that they have enough work to move the expiry dates of the claims from January 12, 2006 to approximately July 2006. He will work with us on this issue and I think we have the solution within current regulations.

On 2) we currently do not have any method for this bond holding. I told Jerry that I would look into this but held out no hope that anything would happen fast.
