REX MOUNTAIN GOLD PROJECT (100 % Spokane Resources Ltd.)

LOCATION Approx. ten miles from Gold Bridge, close to the Bralorne property near Lilloett, British Columbia.

SUMMARY

• The main mineralized trend, auriferous quartz veins, runs from the East to the West Zones, over a strike length of approx. 700 m. and tested between 1950 m. and 2225 m. above sea level.

• Three types of quartz vein systems have been identified. High grade copper and gold mineralization are associated with zones of intense silicification and listwanite alteration. Listwanite occurs adjacent to and as inclusions within auriferous quartz veins.

• The copper to gold ratios for the West and East Zone are 13331:1 and 838:1 respectively. There is a positive correlation between copper and gold, with silver as an economically important byproduct.

• Resource estimates:

West Zone:

94,904 tonnes grading 0.232 opt. Au & 1.06% Cu

East Zone

94,549 tonnes grading 0.268 opt. Au & 0.77% Cu

STRATEGY Further work to increase resource estimates is planned.

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
