Visited with Inspector Ken MacDonald on October 23. Exploration site is east of Williams Creek off of the Downey Pass road. Old workings apparently date to the 1940s (and earlier?) and consist of an adit, developed along an azimuth of 070 degrees, on one or more quartz-sulphide veins, and a series of exploration trails. In 2002, four short holes totaling only 60 metres were drilled in an attempt to intersect the veins-none were successful. Prospecting of a sizeable, moss-encrusted dump yielded several blocks of quartz-pyrite-chalcopyrite vein material up to 30 cm across.

Rim (Herb Wahl and Jack Brown-John)

Visited this interesting flow-top copper prospect near Horsefly with property owner Jack Brown-John on October 24. Native copper, bornite, chalcocite and abundant malachite are characteristic of several outcrops and trenched exposures that cover more than one kilometer in Miocene(?) volcanic rocks, including 'Bird Drop' amygdaloidal basalt flows, a poorly to non-lithified volcanic conglomerate and a volcanic breccia. Several companies are apparently interested in the property.
