## SOCIETY OF ECONOMIC GEOLOGISTS FIELD TRIP - ADVANCED ANNOUNCEMENT AND PRE-REGISTRATION

## MAJOR GOLD-SILVER DEPOSITS OF THE NORTHERN CANADIAN CORDILLERA September 22-26, 1988

ITINERARY: The three deposits to be visited are Cinola (City Resources), Silbak-Premier (Westmin Resources), and Equity Silver mine. Equity Silver is the largest silver producer in the Province; Cinola and Premier are new mines in the preproduction stage. The deposits are volcanic-related, bulk-mineable precious metal deposits. Cinola is a Tertiary hotspring-type epithermal Au deposit; Silbak-Premier is a Jurassic, somewhat deeper-level, epithermal stockwork-type Au-Ag deposit; and Equity Silver is a Ag-Au-Cu-Sb-As deposit transitional between a porphyry copper and epithermal setting.

The tour will provide spectacular coast and mountain scenery in the Queen Charlotte Islands and mainland British Columbia. Technical presentations will include overview lectures, on-site briefings by mine and exploration staff, an underground visit at Cinola, and tours of surface workings at Silbak-Premier and Equity Silver.

DATES: September 22 to 26, 1988 (5 days). Departing in the evening and returning to Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada. The trip involves a scheduled airline and charter flight, and extensive bus transport.

ESTIMATED COST: US \$575 to \$650 depending on the number of participants. All-inclusive cost meets transportation expenses (air and bus travel), accommodation (shared double occupancy), all meals, and handout materials.
