The Silvertip Project in northern British Columbia is a precious and base metals deposit containing a current total resource of 2.57 million tonnes at 6.40% Pb, 8.80% Zn, and 325 grams per tonne Ag with Au credits at 0.63 g/t. It is Silvertip Mining Corporation's intention to develop an open pit and underground mine on the deposit in 1999 to feed a dense media plant and flotation mill producing high value lead and zinc concentrates. The open pit and underground silver-lead-zinc mine is to be located in northern BC near the BC-Yukon border, approximately 85 kilometres southwest of Watson Lake, YT.
