→ 1 g/ton Au in soils but ddh showed must have been enrichment e.g. "dry-land placer"

- Free Au in or not in gtz.

Outlook - u/g vein situation.

Newhawk - 300 ft. in portal - drifting for 100 ft. on SE extension of vein (not main target)

- tunnel started ~ Nov. 6/79.

- no visible Au

Approx. 60 ft. back.

- 1000 ft. (gtz) vein on surface

1980 - 1000 ft. of drifting at Newhawk

- surface ddh at Silver Ridge + u/g tunnel
