

Noramex Minerals Inc. has a 100 percent interest in several claim groups in the Cinola mining camp of central Graham Island. These properties are located on structural breaks (faults), and are favourably situated with respect to the Cinola (City Resources Ltd.) deposit. All of the Noramex Minerals Inc. claims contain either anomalous gold geochemical values, anomalous geophysical values, or both.

Noramex Minerals Inc. is <u>seeking joint venture partners</u> to assist in the exploration of the properties.

The Cinola gold deposit contains 43.8 million tons averaging 0.053 oz Au/ton (2.3 million ounces of contained gold) in a fracture controlled epithermal gold deposit. Reserves include 7 million tons at greater than 0.1 oz/ton mineable by open pit methods. City Resources recently announced an aggressive development program aimed at a production decision in late 1987.
