Exploration and Related Activity:

Cariboo Gold Quartz Still lots of visitors to property. This week included Anglo American and Goldfields. Drilling resumed Thursday with a reconditioned '38' drilling NQ core. Hole 18 is collared on/near set-up used for 1999 holes BK10-15, approximately 400 feet grid-west of 2000 holes BC2K-16 and 17 (and short holes BC2K-6 and 7).

Stope Baby. Gotta love the name! Investigated this new find with Jim Wallis, who optioned the claims from the partnership of Herb Wahl and Jack Brown-John. Intriguing quartz-carbonate-sulphide ladder vein system barely exposed above high waters of spring freshette in canyon on Moffat Creek. (south of Horsefly).

Other News:

OMAR **Lawyers Mine Road.** Sounds like the "Cheni" road north of Sturdy air strip will be de-activated this summer. Too bad MEM can't divert some of the millions taken in from oil and gas revenue, etc., to maintain an important exploration artery to this remote part of the province.

Prospectors Assistance Program. Two more applications received from other RGs for scoring, bringing total to 17 that are fully (15) or partially (2) within the region.
