Note to Registrants for the Sullivan Geology Meeting

The meeting is coming up very soon. Interest is very strong, and registration is now full because of limitations imposed by the largest available meeting room in Kimberley.

I have a few points you should note about this gathering, as follows:

- 1. A desk will be open for pickup of registration kits on Thursday, November 8th from 4:00 to 4:30 p.m. at the Quality Inn Downtown and from 5:00 to 5:30 p.m. at the Trickle Creek Residence Inn by Marriott. If you have made other accommodation arrangements, or you can't get to either hotel on Thursday, you can pick up your kit between 7:45 and 8:30 a.m. on Friday at the North Star Lodge at the ski hill.
- 2. Your registration kit will include numbered tickets for <u>lunch</u> and <u>supper</u> on <u>Friday</u>. Although these are complimentary, a ticket is required because of the notice required by the caterer. If your spouse is accompanying you to Kimberley and is not already registered, he/she is also invited to dinner, but you must let us know by Monday November 1st at the latest.
- 3. If you asked to go to the mine on Saturday and have not been denied due to tours being full, your kit will also have a numbered ticket showing which tour you are on. A schedule for mine tours will be in the registration kit. - 5. Kimberley is on Mountain (= Calgary) Time, at an elevation ranging from 3600 to 4400 feet. Expect snow.
