

SULLIVAN DEEPS

- call from John Murko, St. V. Cold from Kimberley
 → "Game On!" (8:50am)

Deep hole being stopped today @ 9070 ft
 (2765m) - will take break, then begin
wedging a series of short holes

*→ Intersected ~ 25 ft (7.62m) of 'disseminated'
 sulphides (mainly ZnS; no PbS), incl. 6 ft
 (2m) of "massive sulphides" (mainly ZnS).

⇒ 'Classic' BANDED ("museum-type) textures
 ⇒ SG feel they have intersected the "Edge"
 of a new Setex system (no PbS) ⇒ wedging
 to begin to further test.

→ Will move 2nd drill onto property
 ~ 1.5 km E + N of Hole -04-01!
 → then drill another deep hole (several months!)

Swell Deep! 2765m Sullivan basin
Target - min. 50Mt 'sister' deposit (not fault offset)
- on western fringe of proposed target
- wedging in progress
- 2nd drill (Hy Tech) to begin deep hole
~1 km to east - early Jan.
est. wedge hole will be ~ 800m + cost
~ \$500k
