As requested in your letter to Walter Sellmer dated December 4, 1989, please find attached a colour 4"x6" aerial of Table Mountain near Cassiar, B.C., where our Erickson Gold Mine is located. In the centre of the photo is the Cusac area of the Erickson Gold camp where surface exploration during 1989 uncovered several vein targets that were trenched and drilled. Work in 1990 will focus primarily on the Cusac area, an area east of the Erickson Creek fault near the Main Mine, and other targets developed during 1988-89 that warrant additional work.

The view is to the northwest where slightly left of centre on the horizon is Cassiar Mining's asbestos mining operation.
