Visit with Bill Osborne - he provided an oblique photo for our Roundup poster & we had an informative discussion about the property

- Aseko has pulled out (administrative decision?)
- 19,000 ft. ! discontinuous copper soil anomaly (> 200 ppm Cu) trending E-W below Empress zone
- best mzn occurs above granodiorite - alt. rk(?) contact (mod. to intense alt.)
- granodiorite "sheet" dips moderately (locally quite shallow) northward
- most work done in Empress area - development of 3 zones: the '76' zone, Upper North, & Lower North.
- in 1991 mineralization (~.16% Cu) found in relatively fresh granodiorite, previously thought to be barren
- mineralization in the Empress zones is hosted in "quartz rock" & "quartz magnetite rock"
- common float (angular → local??) grab sample of cpy-bearing fine-grained quartz-plag-sulfidated material yield up to 4% Cu & 0.8 opt Au!
- plans for 1992: expand zones eastward → contingent of funding!!
