Andrew Smith and Bernard Gaboury, Iron Mask Explorations: Visit made to the Nanaimo office by 2 representatives of Iron Mask on Feb. 9; Iron Mask is acquiring former properties Jaguar International in the Taseko Lakes area (Kamloops Region) and also acquiring former properties of the Eastheld Group in the Bella Coola area, including the Nifty (MINFILE 093D006) and Cutfinger (MINFILE 093D007); targeting VMS potential in the Southwest Region in general, and working with GSC/GSB crews working this summer near Bella Coola.
