- ⑨ Old camp.

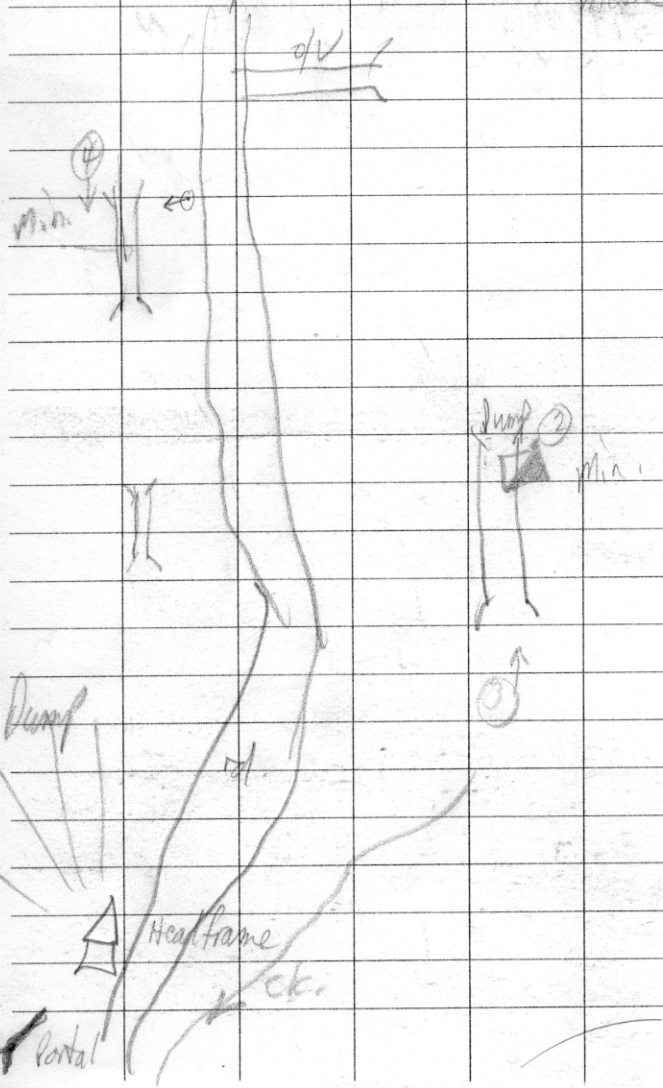

(Cobre)1975 Drilled 4 holes
(can. Sup.)

- Cominco has stored separate boxes of holes with specimens taken every 10 ft.

- looked very briefly at Cominco's 1983 drill core - didn't look too impressive.
