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*CF*. Minister Neufeld's visit to Kamloops - Minister met with community leaders to discuss the Energy Policy and BC Hydro. Adams and Cathro attended at the invitation of MLA Krueger's office. Some discussion of mining and coalbed methane, including a comment from the Minister to the effect that "the Province would arrange for BC Hydro to return the Hat Creek Coal rights to the Province, so that the private sector could evaluate the coalbed methane potential and the mining of thermal coal for export" (Hydro contacted our office this week to say they are giving up the coal rights, and wanted to know about reclamation requirements). The Minister also said that mineral exploration spending would be about "\$50 million this year", which is considerably higher than the \$36-40 million estimate of the RGs/MDO. The Minister's office should probably update their figures.

Kamloops LRMP - Jim Britton (MSRM) reports that the Kamloops Plan Monitoring Team met this week with mining represented by Leo Lindinger (KEG) and Larry Lutjen. No significant decisions were made although the group was supposed to discuss the addition of nearly 1700 Ha to the Bonaparte PA. In addition, BC Parks has been discussing with the City of Kamloops an idea to add another 650 Ha to the Lac Du Bois PA along the city boundary. Examination of claim maps in these areas shows numerous unnecessary No Staking Reserves which we have again asked to have removed (a complete review of all the Kamloops NSRs was promised to the mining sector when the LRMP was completed 7 years ago, and it still hasn't been done). In a related issue, Bill Hall will ask MLA Krueger to try to push through a minor amendment and removal of land from the Lac Du Bois PA (approx 100 Ha) to allow small scale mining of a precious opal prospect. BC Parks has previously opposed this boundary change. If BC Parks want to amend various park boundaries to add big chunks of ground, why can't a small piece be removed at the same time???

Afton Mine (DRC Resources) - Another excellent hole released from the northwest portion of the deposit, beneath the west wall of the pit. Hole 66 hit 200 m (beginning at 446 m) grading 1.20% Cu, 1.7 g/t Au, 0.21 g/t Pd and 4.3 g/t Ag, including 24 metres (beginning at 452 m) grading 2.43% Cu, 4.2 g/t Au, 0.31 g/t Pd and 6.6 g/t Ag (or 5.45% Cu equivalent). The question out there is...is the grade of the deposit high enough to be mined underground?

DP / Tulameen Platinum (Bright Star Ventures) - somewhat disappointing results released for 6 holes drilled into the eastern DP anomaly near Olivine Mountain. Although broad zones of anomalous copper-PGE values were encountered, there were no ore-grade intersections and the Cu and PGE values do not appear to correlate. The best results were:

Bright Star plans to proceed with a large Spring drilling project (>15,000 m) to test the western DP anomaly and other Tulameen complex targets. A \$3 million convertible debenture financing has been proposed.

Geological Association of Canada Vancouver Conference (May 2003) - Asked to help lead two post-meeting field trips to Highland Valley Copper (with Bill McMillan) and the Afton area (as part of a PGE trip led by Graham Nixon). Discussed the second trip with S. Todoruk of Abacus Mining and they have agreed to show us core and Cu-Au-Pd results from Rainbow.

Afton area - discussed palladium potential in the Iron Mask batholith with <u>S</u>. Todoruk of Abacus Mining, who are systematically testing many of the prospects in the district for Pt, Pd and Au. Went in the field with Abacus field people to show them several hard-to-find prospects.

#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

Cariboo College Career Day/Open House (Sat. October 19th) - Cathro and Madu helped organize displays and staff a room for the Kamloops Exploration Group at this event. In addition to MEM posters, brochures, rocks and a gold-panning exhibit, the KEG room included displays and staff from Highland Valley Copper, G&T Metallurgical, Navasota Resources and Eco-Tech Laboratories. Partnership in action!

Gold-Rainbow (Doublestar Resources) - field visit on 10/22 to this epithermal gold prospect (82ESW112) located near Venner Meadow, SE of Okanagan Falls. Under the direction of geologist Murray Morrison, the company is testing several areas of alteration and weak gold mineralization in Tertiary volcanics sitting above a detachment(?) fault. The setting is somewhat analogous to the Dusty Mac and Vault deposits to the northwest. In addition to silica-clay-pyrite-hematite alteration and quartz-calcite vein mineralization in the bangingwall, the fault zone was intersected in several holes returning 50-60 m of silicified volcanics and chlorite-epidote-silica altered footwall gneisses. As usual, assays will determine whether further drilling will occur on this interesting property.

Tulameen Coal (Sompliance Energy) - Mining of 10,000 tonnes of raw coal is underway. Wash plant to be started up this week, and will test the newly mined coal rather than that stockpiled last year.

Zeo (Zeo-Tech Enviro Green) - Mining of 4000 tonnes of zeolite completed. Co. is arranging transport and processing to satisfy a demand of 2500 tonnes of "Zeo-Fume", a zeolite product designed to replace silica fume in specialty concretes.

Tulameen Platinum (Bright Star Ventures) - Drilling of 6 holes (1000 m) has been completed on the DP copperplatinum-palladium target near Olivine Mountain. SW of Tulameen. Assays are eagerly awaited for this potentially significant discovery.

Panorama Ridge (Goldcliff Resource Corp) - Released channel-chip sampling results from the York skarn gold prospect located 3.5 km east of the Nickel Plate mine. An 85.67 interval assayed 0.586 a/t Au, including 28.68 m grading 1.258 g/t Au (similar to previous results by Placer Dome). The values are lower than the historical average grades at Nickel Plate (13.94 g/t Au for underground and 1.98 g/t Au for open pit) but still suggest that a large low-grade deposit is possible on the property.

Lillooet LRMP - answered several requests for information related to the South Chilcotin park and the upcoming LRMP review decision.

Bonaparte No Staking Reserve - At the request of Vancouver client Greg Dawson, we initiated action to review the need for a large NSR north of Kamloops. All NSRs in the Kamloops LRMP were supposed to have been reviewed for their relevance in 1995 when the LRMP was completed, however, this does not appear to have been done. Several parks were created and the remainder of the area should now be opened up.

# HIGHLIGH

Tulameen Platinum (Bright Star Ventures) - encouraging results reported today for the DP zone, which from its tecation and description, appears to be close to the FRM 52 copper prospect (MF 92HSE120) south of Olivine Mountain. Bright Star reported that a 300 by 200 m Pd-Pt-Cu-Au anomaly has been defined by rock sampling and a one metre bedrock chip assayed 2.08 g/t PGE and 0.17% Cu. "Disseminated and fracture-controlled pyrite-chalcopyrite mineralization with malachite staining has been sampled over a large area within magnetite-rich homblende clinopyroxenite". Perhaps most encouraging is the definition of "two significant NNW-trending soil anomalies (up to 280 pob Pt. 195 pob Pd and 4500 pom Cu) which extend over a combined strike length of 2 Km<sup>\*</sup>. Drilling (1000 m) is scheduled to begin within the next 10 days. The company is rumoured to have acquired additional ground recently, including the Lodestone Mountain property to the south.

Lillooet LRMP - An editorial entitled "Buried at Lillooet - BC's Mining Future" appeared in the National Post today. It reinforces the importance of the mineral values in the Lillooet LRMP, and suggests that industry will be watching closely for a strong pro-business signal in the Government's upcoming decision.

Basin Coal (Compliance Energy) - Coal wash plant arrived at Similico site this week and is being assembled.

Elizabeth (J-Pacific Gold) - drilling has been underway for about a week on this gold property located northwest of Lillooet.

Afton (DRC Resources) - rumours of a good hole may be the reason for the stock price jumping up about 60% to \$3.90 since mid August. No news has been released since June 6th.

Elk (Almaden Minerals) - Seguin reported they are on the last hole of a program originally planned for 4500 metres.

Prospect Valley (Almaden) - trenching of this new gold prospect west of Merritt is slated to take place in early October. Epithermal Au-Ag mineralization was discovered last fall by a crew following up an old GSB stream sediment anomaly.

Panorama Ridge (Goldcliff Resources) - reported on results of five excavator trenches, soils, geophysics etc from this skam gold prospect located east of the Nickel Plate mine. Additional claims have been staked. Trenching continues and a tender for drilling has been let.

#### HIGHLIGHTS

**Tulameen Platinum (Bright Star Ventures)** - the company is approx. halfway through a million dollar exploration project looking for platinum group metals in the Tulameen Ultramafic Complex. Another \$3 million debenture financing is being arranged according to Bill Yeomans, VP. Bright Star control a very large property package and is conducting systematic exploration including grassroots geochemical sampling, prospecting, IP, rock sampling etc. A 3000 m drill program is planned for early Sept. They recently announced discovery of a new mineralization south of Olivine Mountain. A very strong magnetic anomaly 1500 m long by 500 m wide is underlain by magnetite-bearing homblende clinopyroxenite with copper staining. Rock sampling has returned assays of 0.435 g/t Pd, 0.205 g.t Pt and 0.14% Cu. Several old pits and a shaft apparently correspond to a MINFILE iron occurrence.

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HIGHLIGHTS:

Afton Area (Abacus Mining and Exploration Corp) - closed \$550K financing which will be spent on the seven properties optioned from Teck Cominco et al. The main focus will be the Rainbow property which hosts the Rainbow #2 and #17 zones. Both are breccia-hosted, alkalic porphyry Cu-Au deposits. Previous work by Teck indicated locally enriched palladium values in the Rainbow deposits (e.g. hole 95-22 hit 33 m grading 0.74% Cu, 0.18 g/t Au and 0.62 g/t Pd).

Kettle Valley Stone Co. - Demand appears strong and sales are growing again after a sharp post-Sept 11 slowdown. Product for several large projects in California was being manufactured at the time of our visit on 1/28.
